List of Chores

- ☐ Clean Bathrooms
- ☐ Unload Dishwasher and Take Out Trash
- ☐ Dirty Clothes
- ☐ Vacuum
- ☐ Bathroom Trash and Stock Toilet Paper
- ☐ Clean Kitchen Table and Kitchen Floor

Clean Bathrooms

- ☐ Spray sink with cleaner.
- ☐ Spray toilet with cleaner.
- ☐ Vacuum or sweep floor.
- ☐ Wipe down sink and rinse.
- ☐ Using toilet brush, clean the toilet bowl.
- ☐ Wipe down in this order, using disposable wipes:
 - ☐ Handle
 - ☐ Lid of toilet
 - ☐ Toilet seat
 - ☐ Base of toilet
- ☐ Put cleaning tools away.

List of Chores

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Unload Dishwasher and Trash

Unload Dishwasher

- ☐ Unload the dishes, putting them away as you go.
 - ☐ Dry off any dishes that are still wet.
 - ☐ Put dishes away in an organized manner.
 - ☐ When putting away plates and bowls, put larger items on the bottom and stack by size.
- ☐ Unload and put away the silverware.
 - ☐ Make sure all of the silverware is dry before putting away.

Trash

- ☐ Put diapers in trash, if needed.
- ☐ Tie the trash bag up.
- ☐ Lift the trash out of the trash can.
- ☐ Make sure it's not leaking.
- ☐ Take trash bag out to the outside trash can.
- ☐ Put a new trash bag in the inside trash can.

Dirty Clothes

- ☐ Gather the dirty clothes and take them to the laundry room.
- ☐ Sort by color:

Lights

Whites
Grays
Light Blue
Yellow
Turquoise
Green

Darks

Black
Jeans
Blue
Purple

Reds

Red
Pink
Orange

Vacuum

- ☐ Get the vacuum out and plug it in.
- ☐ Divide the room into smaller sections.
- ☐ Move and/or turn the vacuum forward in a straight line.
- ☐ Move the vacuum over and pull it back.
- ☐ Repeat until room is complete.
- ☐ Move to next room and repeat previous steps until done.

Bathroom Trash and Stock Toilet Paper

These jobs are well suited for the younger kids, including toddlers.

Bathroom Trash

- ☐ Collect trash cans from the bathrooms and any other places in the house where there are small trash cans.
- ☐ Dump bathroom trash cans into the house trash can. (*Ours is located in the kitchen*)
- ☐ Return trash cans back to its place.

Stock Toilet Paper

- ☐ Count how many rolls of toilet paper are in the bathrooms.
- ☐ Figure out how many you need to equal a total of 3 rolls total. (or an amount you decide)
- ☐ Go to where your toilet paper is stored and collect the amount needed in previous step.
- ☐ Stock the bathroom with needed toilet paper.

Clean Kitchen Table and Kitchen Floor

Clean Kitchen Table

- ☐ Clear table of any objects.
- ☐ Wet rag in warm water and ring it out.
- ☐ Wipe the table starting at one end and scoop crumbs into your hand as you go.
- ☐ Repeat the two previous steps until the table is clean.

Clean Kitchen Floor

- ☐ Pick up large items off the floor.
- ☐ If using a broom:
 - ☐ Sweep the dirt up into a pile or smaller piles around the kitchen and dining area.
 - ☐ Use dustpan to collect the pile(s) and dump in the trash.
- ☐ If using a vacuum:
 - ☐ Get the vacuum out and plug it in.
 - ☐ Divide the room into smaller sections.
 - ☐ Move and/or turn the vacuum forward in a straight line.
 - ☐ Move the vacuum over and pull it back.
 - ☐ Repeat until room is complete.

We use a cordless vacuum for the kitchen, because of the ease of use.
- ☐ Put chairs back to where they belong.
