Definition:

Compliance to a request;
submission

Scripture Reference:

Ephesians 6:1

“Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.”

Bible Story Highlight:

Jonah and the Whale Jonah 1-4

Activity Ideas:

- Watch YouTube videos on obedience.
- Discuss why obedience is important.
- Play “Mommy Says!”
 - When they obey, say “Thank you for obeying the sound of my voice.”
- Play “Follow the Mommy!”
- Play “Obedience Drawing Game.”
 - I give them step-by-step instructions to drawing a picture of my choice. It would sound something like this:
 - Draw a square on the bottom center of the page.
 - Put a triangle on top of the square. (A House)
 - Draw a small rectangle on the bottom of the page in the center of the square. (The Door)
 - Draw a small circle in the middle of the rectangle on the right side. (The Doorknob)
 - Draw a small rectangle on top of one side of the triangle. (A Chimney)
