Class Agenda Example

I have included the class agenda example that is in this post. It is an example of how I divide my one-hour class so that I am creating a diverse learning experience for my students.

Foundational Principles

From there, we move onto the Foundational Principles page. This is where you will determine the three concepts you want your students to walk away with. There is space for you to write those down so that you can remain focused and intentional when you are planning your lesson.

Lesson

The Lesson page is where you are going to plan your opening statements. I always ask myself how I can make the lesson come alive for children. How can I catch their interest and open their minds to what is going to be taught that day? Is there an object lesson that I can do? Is there a story I can tell them from my own life? Is there a story I can read to them?

Activity Stations

This is my favorite one! This is when you get to figure out what your activity stations are going to be. I look at my foundational principles and ask myself what kind of age-appropriate activities can I have the children do that will tie into each principle.

5 Minutes	Getting the children settled, introducing yourself, and teaching classroom rules
10 Minutes	Teach the Lesson
10 Minutes	Activity or Station #1
10 Minutes	Activity or Station #2
10 Minutes	Activity or Station #3
10 Minutes	Conclusion Discussion
5 Minutes	Prepare to Leave

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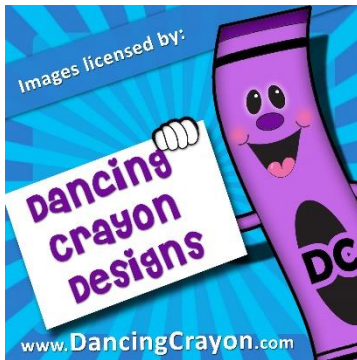
