Easter Eggs Unit Study Leader Instructions

Thank you for downloading this product. This unit study is designed to engage the student in what they are learning. This unit study was created to be facilitated by a leader with group interaction.

Easter Eggs Unit Study Directions:

This unit study is designed to lead the group in hands-on activities, discussions, and other learning. As the activity presents itself, have the child stop and complete it.

What is Sin? Object Lesson

The students will make a list of all the bad things we do daily. The leader will write it in a permanent black marker on a dry erase board. As you discuss how the blood of Jesus covers our sin, color the red dry erase marker over the black permanent marker and then erase it with the dry erase board eraser. The red ink will cause it to erase off the board easily.

Write John 3:16

Have the student look up John 3:16 and copy the bible verse on paper.

Memory Verse Easter Egg Hunt

Before you start the lesson, print off the Memory Verse Easter Egg Hunt Cards and cut them apart. Hide them in colored plastic Easter eggs. Note: If more than one child is playing have them hunt a specific color of eggs so they can get a complete verse to put in order.

Dye Easter Eggs

The students have an opportunity to be creative and dye Easter eggs. Mix the dye with 1 cups of boiling water, 1 teaspoon of vinegar, and 20 drops of food coloring. Use a spoon to remove the eggs after they have soaked for 5 minutes. The students are encouraged to dye one red to symbolize the blood of Jesus.

Note: Double-check all YouTube links prior to showing them to the children. 😊

What is Sin? Object Lesson

Leader's Guide

Sin is all the bad things we do. Let's make a list of the sins we make every day.

1. Write the list of sins in permanent black marker on a dry erase board.
2. When you have completed the list, try to erase them. When it doesn't erase, act shocked and proclaim the dry erase board to be ruined.
3. Then begin to cover the "black sins" with a red dry erase marker. This will make the black permanent marker erase off the board. While you are covering the permanent marker with the red dry erase marker, make the following points:
 - Jesus died on the cross for our sins.
 - His blood covers our sins.
 - He forgives our sin and makes it go away just like this red marker is erasing the black permanent stain.
 - Discuss the plan of salvation with the kids.
 - A- Admit we have sinned.
 - B- Believe that Jesus died on the cross to save us from our sins.
 - C-Confess that He is the Lord of your life.
 - Read John 3:16 together and discuss what it means.

Activity Directions:

2. Follow the directions on the video using 1 cup of boiling water, 1 teaspoon of vinegar, and 20 drops of food coloring.
3. Let the eggs soak for five minutes.
4. Remove them from their soak and let them dry.

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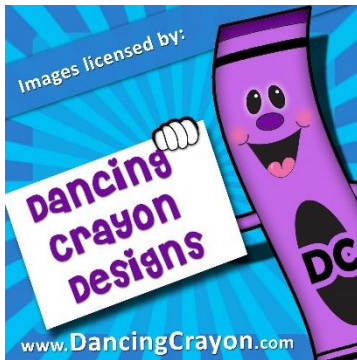
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
