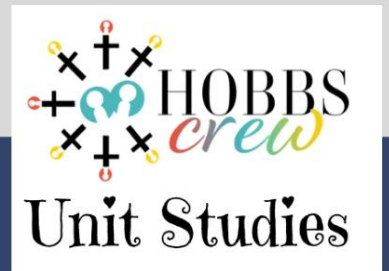

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What Countries Fought in World War II?

Leader Instructions

Thank you for downloading this product. This unit study is designed to engage the student in what they are learning. This unit study was created to be facilitated by a leader with group interaction. I would suggest that you read a book about World War II with your students while you are participating in this study. We have a couple of suggestions at www.hobbscrew.com/ww2.

Special Directions:

YouTube Video: In this lesson, there are links to three YouTube videos to educate the students on World War II. I would recommend that you double-check the videos prior to sharing them with the children.

The Country's Flags In this project, the students will use Worksheets 1 and 2 to draw and color each country's flag that was involved in the war. They will need to look up the country on the internet to see what their flag looks like.

Whose Side Were They On? The students need to cut out the flags while keeping the country's name attached. Have them sort them onto their Allies or Axis Powers worksheets based on who the country fought for.

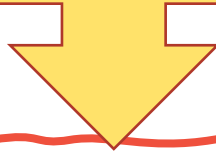
Before they glue them on have them call the leader over to double-check, they have the answers correct. Instead of telling them who they specifically have wrong, just tell them how many are incorrect and let them figure it out. They can call you again when they think they have it all correct. This makes it feel like a game show and so it adds a small challenge in the activity.

Axis Powers vs. Allied Powers Obstacle Course The goal of this activity is for the students to build two different obstacle courses: one for the Allied Powers and one for the Axis Powers. They will place a labeled bucket at the end of each obstacle course. They will select a starting point and place the rest of the cards with the country's name on them in that place.

The student will select a card with the name of a country on it and run the appropriate obstacle course in order to put it in the correctly labeled bucket.

What Countries Fought in World War II?

Have you ever wondered what countries fought in World War II? In this lesson, not only will you learn which countries fought but whose side they fought for.

What Countries Fought in World War II?

"Whose Side Were They On?"

Project Directions:

1. Cut out the flags. Keep the country's name attached unless you can remember who the flags belong too.
2. Find worksheets that say Allied Powers and Axis Powers.
3. Figure out who the country fought for in World War 2 and place the flag on the correct worksheet. Try to do this by memory without looking at the answers.
4. When you think you have the correct answers, have your leader check it.
5. Once you have them all correct, glue them to the appropriate page.

What Countries Fought in World War II?

Axis Powers vs. Allied Powers Obstacle Course

Activity Directions:

1. Cut out the Axis Powers vs. Allied Powers Obstacle Course Game Cards.
2. Get two buckets and tape the Axis Powers card to one and Allied Powers card to the other bucket.
3. Go outside and make two separate obstacle courses.
4. At the end of one obstacle course place one of the buckets and at the end of the other obstacle course place the other bucket.
5. Pick a starting point and place the remaining country cards there.
6. When our leader says go, pick a card with a country's name on it.
7. Figure out whether they fought for the Axis or Allied Powers.
8. Run the obstacle course that has the bucket at the end for the side they fought for.
9. Repeat and take turns until you have used all the country cards.
10. Check your answers to see if you are correct. You can refer to your Country Flag project.

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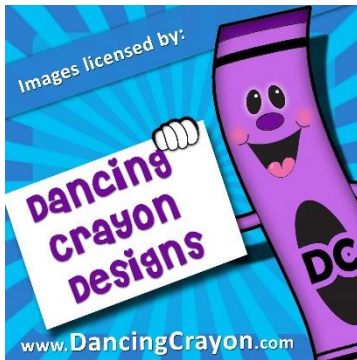
